## 6th Annual TDAA Petit Prix National Agility Tournament

Hello everyone!

Well here are some particulars you have all been waiting for. The TDAA Petit Prix 2009 will be held at the Racine Civic Center <http://www.racinecc.com/> October 9, 10, 11 2009.

Our judges will be Marsha Nix, Beth Moline and Paul Jensen.

The Friday trial with all 3 levels of competition will offer a standard class (Marsha Nix) and Chutes and Ladders (Beth Moline).

We will then have a Team Game Competition playing Strategic Teams with 3 dog teams with Marsha Nix to judge. You may enter with a full 3 member pre-picked team, a pre-picked 2 dog team and add a 3rd dog as a draw or you may enter as a draw and you will be assigned to a team of 3 dogs. This year the team game will be a qualifying game for titles.

Friday evening we will have a wonderful Welcome Reception with a buffet. More details on the Reception to follow.

The tournament will entail 6 quarterfinal, 2 semifinal and 1 final round. All of these rounds will be run on a superior or G3 level course. Details of scoring and advancement will be posted soon to the TDAA website. It will be an exciting competition.

The Tournament will begin Saturday with 4 quarterfinals:

Paul Jensen to judge Standard and Nested Gamblers (ring 1)

Beth Moline to judge Dare 2 Double and Jumpers (no weaves) (ring 2)

On Sunday, 2 more quarterfinal rounds:

Standard judged by Beth Moline and Weakest Link to be judged by Paul Jensen

Those that advance to the semifinal rounds will play Steeplechase judged by Beth Moline and Quidditch judged by Paul Jensen.

The final 40 dogs vying for the championship will advance to play Who Dares Win judged by Paul Jensen.

In addition to the championship competition there will be 2 challenge games that you may play to show your stuff. A 30 Weave Pole Challenge and a Distance Challenge will be set up for you to enter as often as you wish. We will recognize the best dog in each jump height.

We will have ring photographers, a candid photographer and a videographer so you can take lots of memories home with you. More details on this soon.

There have been some special hotel rates made for the TDAA competitors. Karen will be posting that information shortly. We will have lots of vendors with great merchandise, food available on site and a beautiful view.

We expect the premium to be available mid March and much more information soon to come.
