NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.
2. All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the actions of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive activity, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial Site.
3. Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. Refunds will be given to bitches in season, up to when the trial begins.
4. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
6. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
7. At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in being excused from the ring.

Obstacle Familiarization— Obstacle familiarization will be held Friday evening and Saturday and Sunday mornings 30 minutes prior to judging for dogs and handlers who have not previously seen TDAA equipment.

Warm—Ups: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

TDAA uses scaled down equipment on a proportionally set course. All obstacles will be on a small dog scale. See www.k9tdaa.com for details.

Show Site: The show site is indoors on thick cushioned agility flooring in an area of 45x 85. We ask that you exercise the dogs outside and pick up after them.

**Building will be open from 2:00 - 9:00 PM on Friday for set-up, Overview of Teacup Agility and 1 Game.
Building will be open at 7:30 AM on Saturday and 7:00 a.m. on Sunday for set-up.**

You will need to bring crates for your dogs.

X-pens will not be permitted.

Food: Food will be available at the trial site.

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs 17 inches and under at the withers that are over 12 months of age, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Mixed breeds are welcome.

FRIDAY NIGHT: Dogs entered in the Friday night Game will be allowed 2 minutes of individual equipment familiarization time.

GAMES CLASSES

Judge's Briefing on the day of the trial supersedes any previous briefing.

FOUR LEAF CLOVER: Four Leaf Clover is a directional training game. It can be played individually or in teams. The dog performs a numbered sequence. The dog must first perform the weave poles (the stem of the four leaf clover) and then perform each leaf of the clover. The handler can earn bonuses for remaining in the containment area that is bounded by the jumps.

Scoring: Four Leaf Clover is scored points then time. Each handler starts with 100 points. Points lost will be deducted and then bonuses will be added.

LAS VEGAS: Las Vegas is the invention of Ilze Rukis. The object of Las Vegas is to accumulate as many points as possible in 60 seconds by running sequences of varying point value. Time starts when the team crosses the starting line to any chosen sequence. To get the points for a sequence, the dog must complete the sequence without fault.

Scoring: Las Vegas is scored points then time. Time is a tie breaker only. When any sequence is completed without fault (down and back), the team is awarded the face value of that sequence. When a sequence is completed multiple times, point values are awarded as follows: Two of a kind (completed twice) = face value x 2; Three of a kind = face value x 3. Flush (all 3 sequences once) = face value x 5. Straight flush (all three sequences twice) = face value x 10.

BASEBALL: Baseball is a delightful "just for the fun of it" game for agility enthusiasts and their dogs. The dog is required to perform the obstacles in sequence at the handler's direction and in the order designated by the judge. Bonuses are awarded for each base the dog gets to while the handler stays on the pitcher's mound. A home run may be scored if the handler leaves the dog in a stay at the start line, stands inside the area designated as the pitcher's mound and remains on the pitcher's mound throughout the dog's performance.

Scoring: Baseball is scored time plus faults minus bonus. The team with the lowest score wins.

COLORS: Colors is the invention of Linda Eickholdt and Rob Robinson. The objective is to successfully negotiate one of three overlapping agility mini-courses. The handler may choose which course to run. Colored markers label each course: red; blue and yellow. The handler informs the gate steward which course he will be running and the gate steward conveys the choice to the judge and scribe.

Scoring: Colors is scored faults then time. The winner is the dog with the fewest faults. Time is a tie breaker.

TUNNEL VISION: Tunnel Vision is the invention of Darlene Woz, one of the foremost innovators in agility games development. This is the perfect game for a club rich in pipe tunnels and want something really fun and really different to play. Tunnel Vision is played on a course consisting of only pipe tunnels, jumps and weave poles. All obstacles can be taken in either direction; Each clump of tunnels may be performed in any order and any direction as long as each tunnel is performed & the handler must remain behind the containment line for each group of tunnels.

Scoring: Tunnel Vision is scored points, minus faults, then time. The winner is the dog with the highest score.

STANDARD CLASSES

BEGINNER AGILITY: All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY: Dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agility Dog (TBAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY: Dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agility Dog (TIAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES CLASSES

GAMES I: All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations

GAMES II: Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III: Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge.

4" jump height: For dogs 8" and under at the withers; long backed dogs 12" or less; dogs 12" or less with a 50% or less leg to shoulder ratio.

8" jump height: For dogs 12" and under at the withers; long backed dogs 15" or less; dogs 15" or less with a 50% or less leg to shoulder ratio.

12" jump height: For dogs 15" and under at the withers; long backed dogs 17" or less; dogs 17" or less with a 50% or less leg to shoulder ratio.

16" jump height: For dogs 17" and less at the withers.

Jump Height Exemptions

"Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed; have a weight to height exemption; or who have dwarfish legs. (See rules for complete description of height exemptions)

A jump height exemption (next lower jump height) will also be granted to veteran dogs. (Dogs of at least 7 years of age)

NEW CLASS

FEO: TDAA now offers FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. No treats or toys are allowed in the ring.

Day of Event entries WILL BE accepted at an additional fee (See above). Day of Event entries must be given to the Trial Secretary no less than 30 minutes before judging starts. TDAA Registration numbers may be applied for and received at the event so that your dog can participate.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery.

All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms.

Photocopied entries without the signed TDAA agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Returned Checks: The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Refunds: No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Review your information before submitting the Entry Form. Incomplete forms will be returned. Please submit one form for each dog entered. If you already have one, include a copy of your TDAA height card for each dog, otherwise your dog will have to be measured.

How the Fast Track Move Up Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis.

A dog with a higher title may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score.

It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginners and then qualifies again in Intermediate.

Likewise, in Games classes, moving from Games I to Games II and then from Games II to Games III.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next level. The dog’s owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.
