A warm up area, consisting of regulation TDAA equipment, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels.

This trial will be held indoors on ¾" rubber mats. Bldg is heated.

Eligibility – This trial is open to all dogs under 17” and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog’s physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Intermediate Agility - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

TDAA now offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring.

GAMES

Boston Bowling

The game consists of two short courses, each starting with a specific entry to one of two tunnels. The handler “bowls” his dog by sending the dog ahead into a tunnel entrance. Each dog-and-handler team has two bowls. The handler may not step over the penalty line (the start line) as she bowls her dog into one of the tunnel entrances.

Jumpers

The course must be run in the sequence specified by the judge. The dog will earn bonus points for successfully performing the distance challenge. The bonus will be added to the dog’s total score. A standard course time will be set. Time faults will be subtracted from the total score. Jumps and tunnels may be used in this course.

Black Jack

The purpose of this game is to accumulate 21 points in the fastest time. Accumulating more than 21 points disqualifies the team. At least one corner, one side, and one jump must be completed successfully. Corners are typically made from tunnels placed in the corner of the course; sides are contacts and weaves poles, which are placed along the side of the course. The jumps are arranged in the random fashion in the middle.

Chutes And Ladders

The objective of Chutes and Ladders is to negotiate the course of tunnels and contact obstacles. All contact obstacles may be used. A gong is placed on the course which the handler may strike for insurance against faults on a challenge sequence designated by the judge.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. Likewise, it is possible to move up from Games I to Games III by earning qualifying scores in each of the lower levels of Games. The dog’s owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. **Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with this FAST TRACK Move-Up Request form. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. The Fast Track fee is a one-time fee for this trial only.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, being the warm-up area and the designated off leash area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

* PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS

* In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.

* Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

* Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

* Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

* At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

* Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

* Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.

* **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

* The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. Full refunds will be given provided the trial secretary is notified by email prior to the end of the first day of the trial, April 24, 2010 @ 6pm, otherwise there will be no refund issued, veterinarian confirmation is not required.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their division will be eliminated. A judge must measure provisional dogs.

4" jump height - restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less

8" jump height - restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 15" or less.

12" jump height - restricted to dogs measuring 15" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less.

16" jump height - restricted to dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers.

Special provisions are made for the dogs that are long-backed, or dogs whose depth of chest is greater than his legs length.

E1 - Long backed dogs - The long-backed dog would be based on the measurements of the dog from the front of the chest to the back of his rear compared to the measurement of the dog's height at the withers. As a rule of thumb, if the dog's length is 150% or greater than the height measurement, the dog would qualify for this exemption.

E2 - Weight to length provision (by structure, not obesity) - This exemption should be limited to certain breeds that have a propensity for weight that is greater than their height if you compare pounds to inches.

E 3 - Dogs with dwarfish legs/deep chest dogs - This exemption is granted to dogs whose leg to shoulders height ratio is 1/3 or less of the dog's overall height. The exemption for dog's with dwarfish legs is based on the measurement of the dog's withers height, when that height is 150% or greater than the measurement of the space from the floor to chest veteran dog is a dog at least 7 years of age. There is no special system of titling for veteran dogs.

A dog also may be given a waiver to jump at a lower height even though he does not meet any of the criteria for a jump height exemption. A waiver will be given to a dog for extraordinary circumstance. Dogs given a waiver to a lower jump height will be able to earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles.

A copy of your TDAA height card must accompany your entry or be presented at check in. Dog's without a TDAA height card must be measured before running in this trial.
